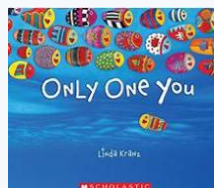
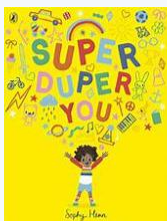


Communication & Language

This half term we will focus on teaching the skill of 'good listening'. We will be encouraging children to speak using full sentences and to answer questions about stories they have listened to.

These will be some of our core texts:



Literacy

We will introduce 'Drawing Club' to open up the magic world of stories. The aim is to enrich language, develop fine motor skills, and build upon phonic knowledge. We will also learn to write our name independently.

Phonics

We will be learning to recognise and write Read Write Inc set one sounds and to blend sounds to read CVC words for example h-a-t.

Maths

Through play and hands on learning we will be learning to:

Match, sort and identify sets.

Compare amounts in sets of objects.

Understand that pattern is a repeated unit. Copy and extend simple patterns.

Compare and order objects based on size, capacity or mass.

Represent, compare and compose the numbers 1, 2 and 3.

Key questions:

What is the same about these objects?

What is different about these objects?

Can you find one that is different to mine?

Does this container hold more or less?

How can you find out?

How does the pattern continue?

What mistake can you see in my pattern?

How many ways can you find 1/2/3?

What is 1 more/less than _?

What is the number after/before _?

Topic

Our topic this half term enables us to get to know each other and gives the children opportunities to talk about things that are important to them, like their families and homes. We will learn about people in the community that are there to help us (doctors, police and firefighters). As the seasons begin to change, we will explore the signs of autumn and learn about Harvest through stories, songs, creative activities
